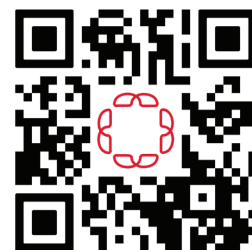

FIRE ALARMS & EVACUATIONS

- Fire alarms may be triggered by smoke, fire, water flow, or other emergencies.
- In the event of an emergency, the **Orlando Fire Department** will respond within minutes.
- The Hotel Event Manager will notify **AGMU Administration** if evacuation is necessary.
- Please pay attention to announcements throughout the building
- Security and emergency personnel will determine the cause of the alarm and the appropriate course of action within a few minutes.
- The alarm will be silenced once it is safe to do so.
- Follow the instructions of **Security** personnel and public address system at all times.

ACTIVE SHOOTER PROTOCOL

- In the event of an active shooter, please follow the procedures below:
- If you are nearby, **hide and remain calm**.
- If you are at a distance, evacuate to a safe location.
- Security personnel will assist with evacuation, while officers from the **Orlando Police Department** will take control to eliminate the threat.
- Identify **emergency exits** and follow the instructions of security personnel in the event of an evacuation.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

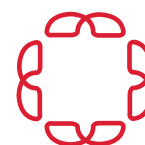
- In the event of a medical emergency, call 911 and notify the security personnel present at the event.
- The closest hospital to the Loews Royal Pacific Resort is **Orlando Health Dr. P. Phillips Hospital**, located **5 minutes** away (3 miles).
- Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) and paramedics assigned to the event will respond to the emergency.
- A **Loews Hotels** security representative will also assist with the incident and document the incident.

NOT ALLOWED

- Smoking inside the facility. (Use outdoor designated areas only.)
- Solid or liquid food in glass containers in the event area.
- Entry of promotional items.
- Equipment or devices that produce noise, such as air horns or whistles.
- The entry of helium balloons into the area designated for AGMU graduation ceremonies.
- Baskets, large arrangements, or any object that could interfere with or obstruct an emergency evacuation in the event area.
- Activities that may disrupt order on the premises or interrupt the graduation ceremonies.
- Graduates marching accompanied by family members or children (for safety reasons).
- Visitors or graduates wearing masks or costumes that conceal their faces.



- An admission ticket is required for entry to the event.
- Firearms are strictly prohibited for both graduates and guests.
- The possession of weapons, including knives, blades, chemical agents such as pepper spray, and any other items deemed hazardous, is strictly prohibited.
