Financial Aid Office National Student Loan Database System (NSLDS)

The National Student Loan Database System (NSLDS) is the U.S. Department of Education's central database for student financial aid. There, financial aid professionals can access information about students' federal loans and/or federal grants as reported by Colleges and Universities that they have attended. Ana G. Méndez University uses the student's social security number, date of birth and first name to review NSLDS data upon student enrollment and new academic year packaging to ensure availability of funds and loan status. The University reports enrollment status to NSLDS within 30 days of loans being disbursed. NSLDS does not include data from private student loans.

Students can access their financial aid history and usage by visiting <u>https://studentaid.gov/</u> on their computer or mobile device, using a secured connection.

Once logged in, students will be able to find information on:

- Loans that were disbursed
- Loan servicer information
- Repayment options
- Enrollment history
- Pell usage and availability
- Other tools related to loan repayment
