Financial Aid Packaging Process

Awarding of Title IV funds

Financial Aid is awarded to students who meet all eligibility requirements as determined by the Federal Department of Education, and who demonstrate a financial need. The award packaging process is executed by the financial aid office, using the processing system, Anthology.

Federal Grants, scholarships, federal student loans and federal work- study programs are available to eligible students enrolled in an eligible program of study (diploma, undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral programs).

To be eligible for packaging, a student must complete and submit their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the current academic year of enrollment.

Funds are awarded as follows:

- Federal Pell Grant
- Federal SEOG
- State Grants
- Federal Direct Subsidized Loan
- Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan

The student will be notified every time a fund source is awarded. If packaging changes arise, a notification of change will also be generated and sent to the student.

All notifications are sent through the student's institutional email address and the student portal.
