Program Description

The Associate of Science in Health Services Management prepares students in the administrative aspects of healthcare. The program will deliver knowledge along with core courses in health services management, accounting, and human resources, and an introduction to public health education.

Program Outcomes

The student will:

1. Demonstrate foundational knowledge of core health services concepts.
2. Apply principles of health services management, service planning, and public health to support effective healthcare delivery.
3. Communicate clearly and professionally with patients, families, and healthcare professionals across diverse settings.
4. Employ critical thinking and problem-solving skills to address challenges in healthcare environments.
5. Identify and integrate ethical, legal, and cultural considerations into the delivery of health services.
