**Procrastination Workshop:** On September 12, over 200 students participated in a workshop that provided valuable time management strategies, led by Lic. David Fuentes.

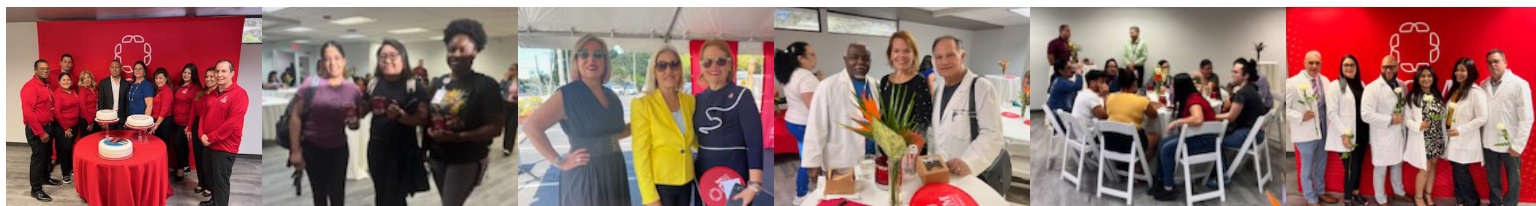

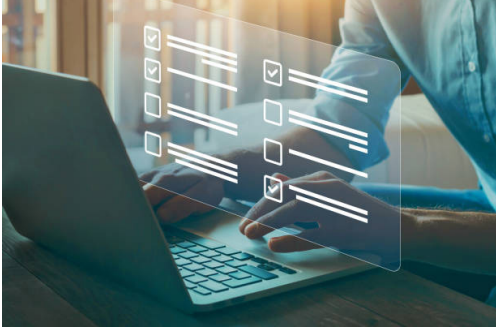
